







We are responsible for the burning of Two Hana Bank ATM machines, the Hana Bank office building, a capitalist-owned advertising videotron, and a motor vehicle belonging to the Indonesian National Army. The arson occurred after a space occupation carried out by demonstrators in the aftermath of a demonstration against the passage of the Indonesian National Army Law (TNI law), the arson occurred in Bandung, West Java on Friday night 21/03/2025.

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Following the coup, Indonesia was ruled by its second dictator, General Soeharto, the mastermind behind the overthrow of the first president. He maintained the dual function of ABRI/TNI for 30 years until he was finally forced to step down in 1998. During Soeharto's rule, the Indonesian people endured multiple massacres, beginning with the mass killing of millions of communist sympathizers in 1965, witch hunts in the 1980s, the massacre of Muslim clerics, and many more. Additionally there were abductions of activists between 1995 and 1998, along with the PETRUS (Mysterious Shooter) operation in the same period, where activists and criminals were executed without trial and their bodies were left on the streets—aimed at terrorizing the public.

After Soeharto stepped down in 1998, the era of reform began. Now, his son-in-law, Mr. Prabowo Subianto—formerly a general and involved in the abduction of activists—was elected as Indonesia's president in 2024.

Within less than 150 days in office, he reinstated the military's dual function (Dwifungsi TNI), allowing soldiers to once again enter civilian and political domains. The process of its enactment was highly questionable. The parliamentary meeting was held in a luxury hotel instead of the parliament building—despite his simultaneous budget cuts under the guise of efficiency. Three days later, the Dwifungsi TNI law was passed, despite widespread public protests.

What you see in the pictures is a mass demonstration demanding the repeal of this law. Beyond the reinstatement of the military's dual function, there are plans to introduce a similar dual-function law for the police. Indonesia is heading toward a military dictatorship.

There is too much history about Indonesia from the early days of independence to the present. It is often written by media outlets (owned by the regime) that have political interests in power and economic control. However, what I have written above is history that has been deliberately erased and is the result of research by several historians who are experts in their field. Since the beginning—especially during the Suharto era—Indonesia's history has also been



The action carried out by the demonstrators in front of the Regional House of Representatives (DPRD) was not ignored at all by anti-riot police, despite the throwing of molotov cocktails, propane, stones and firecrackers into the veranda of the building. Until in the end, we chose direct action by burning at several points above.

Some Background to Explain These Latest actions

In 1963, 18 years after Indonesia broke free from Dutch and British colonialism/imperialism, the first president, Sukarno, established the dual function (Dwifungsi) of the Indonesian Armed Forces (ABRI), now known as the Indonesian National Armed Forces (TNI). His reasoning was to allow the military to be involved in civilian and political affairs, as Indonesia was then leaning towards the communist bloc. Unfortunately, Sukarno was betrayed by the military, as the TNI strongly opposed the Indonesian Communist Party (PKI), leading to a coup against him.
