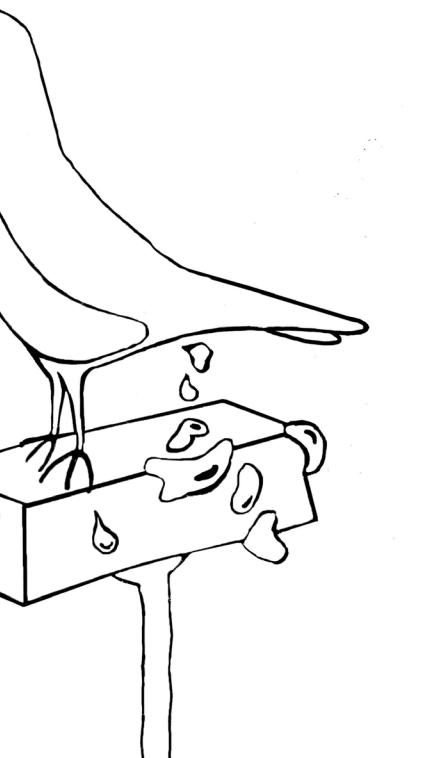

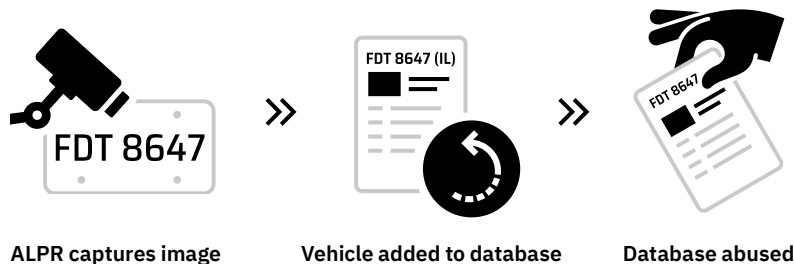
01 INTRO

WHAT'S AN ALPR?

Automated license plate readers (ALPR) are AI-controlled camera systems that are typically mounted on street poles, streetlights, and highway overpasses, capturing thousands of plates per minute. They collect extensive identifying data on every passing vehicle and, by extension, on every person regardless of whether the driver is suspected of any wrongdoing, enabling their clients unprecedented levels of warrantless access to our location history and live location tracking. Government clients, including the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and other law enforcement agencies, have actively abused these unregulated capabilities to stalk, harm, and kidnap people.

HOW THEY WORK

ALPR cameras use motion sensors to detect movement, then automatically capture a series of photos. These images are instantly uploaded to a central database, where AI logs the license plate, the vehicle's make, model, color, and any distinguishing features (e.g., bumper stickers, roof racks, dents, etc.) along with the date, time, and location. Although the vendor only stores the data for 30 days, during that time clients like DHS can download, distribute, and retain it indefinitely. Vehicles can be flagged for longer retention and automatically tracked across multiple ALPRs, enabling law enforcement to track any vehicle traveling across the country in real time with a simple search, like “silver Camry with Bears sticker”.



WHO PRODUCES AND USES THEM

‘Flock camera’ has become a genericized trademark for ALPR technology, much like Kleenex is commonly used for tissue. Flock Safety is one of the most common ALPR vendors in the U.S., along with Vigilant Solutions (a subsidiary of Motorola Solutions), Axon, Jenoptik, Rekor, ELSAG, and Perceptics.

Local police departments who buy ALPR cameras and database access have been known to share data with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), even in states where this is illegal. This has been an ongoing issue since at least 2019, when the ACLU uncovered that ICE was using ALPR data from local police to facilitate deportations.¹ At the time, this spanned over 80 local law enforcement agencies, including four in Illinois: Lombard, Burr Ridge, Downers Grove, and Mundelein. In May 2025, 404 Media reported that “more than 4,000 nation and statewide lookups by local and state police were done either at the behest of the federal government or as an “informal” favor to federal law enforcement with a potential immigration focus, according to statements from police departments and sheriff offices.”²

WHO PAYS FOR THEM

For years, surveillance companies have quietly pocketed over \$37 million in Chicago taxpayer dollars. Since 2016, Chicago has authorized massive, fragmented taxpayer-funded budgets for projects centered on ALPR and vehicle tracking systems. These multi-million dollar contracts covering hardware, software, and maintenance are buried in obscure infrastructure budgets and discretionary ward accounts, manipulating taxpayers into unknowingly bankrolling their own surveillance. It is a staggering investment in turning streets and expressways into permanent tracking zones.

LAW ENFORCEMENT ABUSE

TACTICS

ALPR data is gathered indiscriminately on millions of ordinary people. By mapping vehicle locations and tracing movements, police can construct detailed profiles of drivers' lives, determining past patterns and even predicting future behavior. This is done entirely without cause, as the vast majority of people whose plates are scanned have never been accused of a crime.

ROLE IN HELPING ICE

Local police around the country are performing database lookups for "immigration" related searches and as part of other ICE investigations. In Illinois, this is a direct violation of the TRUST Act³, which limits state and local participation in federal immigration enforcement based solely on immigration or citizenship status and bars cooperation with ICE detainers or administrative warrants. Violating this creates a precedent that gives ICE unrestricted access to surveillance systems, lacking any public oversight or accountability. Although no ALPR vendors hold direct contracts with ICE or Homeland Security Investigations (HSI), these agencies routinely circumvent that barrier by accessing ALPR databases through local law enforcement.

Illinois law bans ALPR use for immigration enforcement, and yet, there are many examples of police departments using ALPRs for this exact purpose. Data obtained via a public records request from the Danville, IL police department reveals more than 4,000 Flock search logs from police departments across the country. Andrew Perley, deputy chief of the Village of Glencoe, IL police department divulged that a specific ALPR search "was not related to an investigation involving immigration status" and instead came from an "informal request from Homeland Security Investigations into a criminal matter aside from immigration."² Palos Heights Detective Todd Hutchinson, who was the only member of his DEA task force with access to the Flock ALPR database, shared his login with federal agents. turn, one agent used that access in January 2025 to run searches labeled “immigration violation.” Palos Heights’ police chief Mike Yott told reporters that his department does not perform immigration enforcement, but said he could not explain Hutchinson’s search.⁴

Edwin Yohnka, director of communications and public policy for ACLU Illinois, told 404 Media, “What is incredibly frustrating is that Flock in particular in Illinois marketed themselves to a bunch of communities in the suburbs and in Central Illinois as a device that would be critical to combating an uptick in crime, violent crime, gun violence. But this is really a national system of data once you start collecting this, whether it’s Bloomington or Springfield or Danville, you start looping together those networks. So it is incredibly troubling to see this list of places from around the country who are performing these searches of Illinois cameras.”²

POLICE ABUSE

The following are just a few of the documented instances of law enforcement abusing ALPR cameras to commit crimes and surveil law-abiding citizens. Because accessing the nationwide camera network requires no warrant and operates with minimal oversight, officers frequently log searches with vague justifications like “investigation.”

Recently, the Johnson County, TX sheriff’s office ran a nationwide search of more than 83,345 cameras across 6,809 Flock networks over the course of one month to locate a woman after an abortion. The officer entered the reason for searching as “had an abortion, search for female.” While abortion is illegal in Texas, some of the cameras searched were in states where abortion is legal, including Illinois. This appalling example raises concerns about surveillance beyond state jurisdiction, increases fear of traveling for lawful care, and could enable future investigations or prosecutions.⁵

There are many instances of police using ALPR networks to stalk romantic interests. In 2026, Florida police officer Lamar Roman illegally used multiple police databases to obtain the full name and driver’s license number of a woman he was stalking. Citing the purpose of the search as a “background investigation,” he then used an ALPR system called Guardian to create a surveillance hotlist so he would be alerted whenever she drove by a camera. After receiving a notification, he recklessly sped along a two-lane highway, nearly causing a head-on collision, to pull her over and harass her without any reason to believe she’d committed a crime.⁶

ALPR camera errors can quickly escalate into life threatening police encounters, such as in Aurora, CO when police drew their weapons on a Black mother and her children after a license plate scanner incorrectly flagged their SUV as a stolen motorcycle from another state. According to witnesses, several officers forced the mother and children face down onto hot asphalt, where they were handcuffed and interrogated before being released.⁷

Alongside other surveillance tools, agencies have used ALPRs to track protesters by scanning thousands of camera networks for vehicles associated with demonstrations, citing the reason as “protest” or something similar. At least 19 agencies across the country conducted searches linked to No Kings protests, including the Lisle, IL police department.⁸

Access logs from 2025 and 2026 show that Flock’s Vice President of Strategic Relations & Business Development Bob Carter⁹, along with other Flock employees, accessed live camera feeds while pitching their dragnet surveillance technology to the Dunwoody, GA police department.¹⁰ Even

BOYCOTT COMPANIES WITH ALPR CONTRACTS

Every purchase made at a store equipped with ALPRs subsidizes this dystopian surveillance network. If a business chooses to prioritize invasive tracking over your civil liberties, make your choice clear by taking your dollar elsewhere. Refuse to shop at or even visit any establishment that installs these systems, such as Home Depot, Lowe’s, Target, and Walmart. Contact these companies and tell them you’ll no longer shop there due to their invasive surveillance practices, and encourage others to do the same.²²

SURVEILLANCE DEFENSE

Fucking shit up is fun and sometimes necessary, no doubt, but rushing headlong into illegal activity is never advisable. Do you have a plan? A strategy? Have you performed a personal risk assessment? If you get caught, do you have someone to feed your dog?

Many brave individuals have undertaken this effort,²³ some have been caught, some have not. We recommend taking your time and trying out some of the legal means of fighting back to gain experience and knowledge before you consider actions that could have serious consequences.

A theoretical example of such an action may involve using cash to purchase a battery-operated reciprocating saw and 6 inch Diablo Steel Demon blades (since angle grinders are very noisy) from a far away store. This example might also include carefully making a plan with trusted friends, covering all skin and hair, and leaving phones and other smart devices at home when you test your new purchase at a location you don’t frequent. In this example, multiple exit routes should be planned in case something seems off, and you should write a phone number for legal representation on your arm beforehand. A less risky example might include using a pole to tilt a camera away from the road and sidewalk, or could have something to do with spray paint or lasers. For more on this subject, check out the zine “Birds of a Feather Destroy Flock Together” linked in the Resources section of this zine.

Although destroying infrastructure does have an impact, you must think about, accept, and plan for the potentially life-changing consequences of your actions. Remember you’re not alone, and there are other viable actions aside from smashing cameras.

- Share relevant legislation and action items with like-minded individuals. It prompts them to do the same and shares the work of reading proposed bills. Practice the tips laid out in this section together.
- Follow media channels and outlets that report on surveillance, like WIRED, 404 Media, Unraveled Press, and set news alerts for yourself.

INFLUENCE YOUR ELECTED OFFICIALS

- Ask your electeds to vote against further funding of ALPRs. Call or email to express your concerns and educate them on how problematic ALPRs are. Officials are frequently given the vendor's sales pitch with no counter-points.
- Talk to the constituents of aldermen, commissioners, mayors, etc. who oppose surveillance. Encourage them to contact their elected officials who support it.
- Donate and volunteer with campaigns that oppose surveillance.
- Submit witness slips to express your support or opposition.²¹

FLYER NEAR CAMERAS

Use DeFlock.org to find cameras in a busy area, go there, and distribute literature (like this zine!) and talk with people walking by. Additionally, wheatpaste posters or put up stickers nearby to warn others. Be sure to plan your route with DontGetFlocked.com, do not bring phones or other smart devices, and consider wearing a mask.

GO CAMERA SPOTTING

Help keep yourself and others informed by submitting ALPR cameras to DeFlock via their iOS or Android app or their legacy editor at DeFlock.org/Report. Keep your eyes peeled in your day-to-day routines, paying extra attention to streetlights, traffic lights, and highway overpasses. This is more effectively done in groups, posing as people who are trash picking. More cameras are discovered every day, so when you spot one don't assume it's already on the map.

more alarming, they chose, of all places, to show the police live footage of children's swimming pools, gymnastics classes, and playgrounds. Implications aside, this is a clear contradiction of Flock's own FAQ page,¹¹ which states that "Flock will not share, sell, or access your data" and "nobody from Flock Safety is accessing or monitoring your footage." The news of this egregious privacy violation sparked protest from residents just as Dunwoody City Council prepared to renew its contract with Flock. Despite expressing "frustration" with Flock's actions, Mayor Lynn Deutsch still supported the renewal, costing outraged residents \$15,000 in tax dollars.¹²

DATABASE HACKING

ALPR databases are an attractive and easy score for hackers. Recently, a security researcher used publicly available network scanning tools to find over 170 live cameras in major U.S. cities, including Chicago. Leveraging several major security vulnerabilities, such as default passwords and unencrypted traffic, they gained administrative access to ALPRs monitoring the public within minutes.¹³

YES, YOU HAVE SOMETHING TO HIDE

History shows that if surveillance goes unchecked, it eventually targets the innocent, stifles dissent, and suppresses free speech. Just because you're not doing anything "wrong" today doesn't mean you won't be accused of something tomorrow. Any movement, from a trip to a protest, a friend's house, or even a misread can flag you as suspicious to authorities. Collected records can be combined, stored indefinitely, and weaponized to punish, shame, deny opportunities, or strip rights for things big brother doesn't like.

03 TIPS

AVOID CAMERAS

Go to DeFlock.org to find a map of cameras in your area and screenshot for future reference. New cameras are discovered all the time, so if it's not on the map, that doesn't mean there isn't one there. To contribute to DeFlock, see the "What You Can Do" section of this zine.

Use DontGetFlocked.com to plan routes that avoid ALPRs. Their Flock Hopper tool shows camera locations and calculates alternative routes that minimize camera exposure for cars, bicycles, and pedestrians. All processing occurs locally, so there is no tracking or analytics involved.

KNOW IF YOU'VE BEEN SEARCHED

Use HaveIBeenFlocked.com to see if your plate has been searched.

OBSCURE YOUR PLATE

Make your license plate more difficult for the cameras to capture. Ways to do this include using a bike rack, smearing your license plate with mud or snow, replacing the plate with a fake temporary tag, or using a remote license plate cover. Obviously, you're risking potential charges and harassment from law enforcement, so reserve obscuring your plate for times when privacy is most needed, such as when driving to an action or when responding to an ICE sighting.

CAR BLOC

Since ALPRs record a vehicle finger print which includes bumper stickers, after-market modifications, bike racks, dents, and scratches, you could add or remove identifying items for a period of time to confuse the AL. Examples include magnetic bumper stickers, drawn on scratches with a window marker, or duct tape on your bumper, to name a few. It is unknown how well this works in practice, but an idea worth exploring.

04 WHAT YOU CAN DO

Government officials at all levels (federal, state, county, city) control ALPR adoption and usage through budget decisions and legislation. We can influence these outcomes by pressuring our elected representatives. While reps may be less responsive to non-constituents outside their districts, we can amplify our impact by educating and activating voters across other areas to take similar action.

EXAMPLES OF PAST OPPORTUNITIES

- Representative Scott Perry (R-PA) and Representative Jesús "Chuy" García (D-IL) introduced an amendment at a House committee markup hearing that would prohibit any recipient of federal highway funding from using ALPRs for any purpose other than tolling. This is a sweeping restriction that, if adopted, would bring an immediate end to state and local ALPR programs across the U.S.¹⁴
- Illinois General Assembly proposed restrictions on use of ALPRs and requirements to disclose their use via FOIA requests. HB5151¹⁵ would create the Automated License Plate Recognition System Act, which sets provisions regarding authorized uses of an ALPR system, data retention, prohibited uses of an automated license plate recognition system, restrictions, requirements for use, preservation & disclosure, required data collection, reporting requirements, admissibility, privacy, penalties, and a private right of action.
- Cook County board of commissioners approved a \$900,000 budget line, allowing continuation of services and increase the number of stationary Flock Safety ALPRs.¹⁶

FINDING RELEVANT LEGISLATION

- Follow the committee hearing schedules of State House sessions and search for committees¹⁷ that fit themes relevant to surveillance. Some examples include Public Safety & Infrastructure,¹⁸ Cybersecurity, Data Analytics, & IT,¹⁹ and Immigration & Human Rights.²⁰
